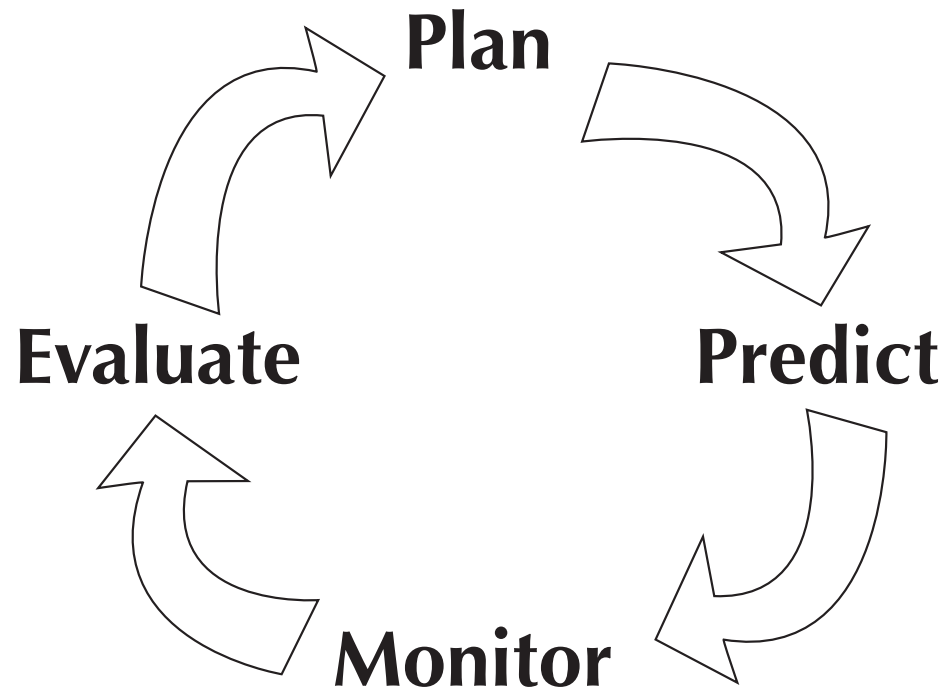


Online Comprehension Strategies Diagram

- What do I need to find out?
- Where should I begin?
- Where do I want to go?
- What do I need to do first?



- Does this choice bring me closer or further away from my goal?
- Is this an appropriate place for all of the information that I need?
- Should I link to a deeper level, select a related topic, click back, or start again?

- Where will this hyperlink lead?
- What kind of site is this?

- Is this where I expected to be?
- What information stands out on the page?
- Should I skim or read more carefully?
- Does this make sense?
